ROLE DESCRIPTION:

The incumbent may be required to travel to provide support for pan-India activities and may be required to participate in Regional and/or National level meetings or scientific conferences.

1. A Masters in Life Science, Public Health, or Bachelors in Medicine or Allied Health Sciences. PhD in above mentioned disciplines will be an added advantage
2. A minimum **12 years** of relevant experience in public health or research field
3. Proof of qualifications or conduct of research
4. Ideally candidates should have experience working in the development sector and/or have worked previously on oncology studies or projects.
5. Proven record of producing high quality publications and presentations in scientific meetings
6. Should have strong demonstrated project management and monitoring and evaluation skills
7. Demonstrated ability to independently design and execute projects that lead to concrete research, training, and public dissemination activities.
8. Experience in writing proposals, grant applications, analyzing data and preparing reports
9. Good organizational abilities, including familiarity with budgeting
10. Excellent interpersonal and leadership skills and a demonstrated ability to manage teams
11. Ideally candidates should have experience working in the development sector and/or have worked previously on oncology studies or projects.
